### **WHAT:**

A total of \$1,000.00 will be awarded.

### **WHEN and HOW:**

Applications are in the vertical file in the Skater's Locker Room and on the club website [www.rmfs.org](http://www.rmfs.org) .

**Scholarship applications are must be received in the RMFSC lock box in the Skater's Locker Room at the Ice Center at the Promenade, or by your primary coach or mailed to RMFSC, 164 Mountain View Ct., Louisville, CO 80027 by September 3, 2010.**

Scholarship funds must be used within nine (9) months of the date of the award. Payment will be upon submission of receipts for the skating related activity.

### **CRITERIA:**

- 1) The skater is a **full** member in good standing of the RMFSC and has been a full member for the previous full membership year without lapse in membership.
- 2) The skater has passed the Juvenile Freeskate OR Adult Silver OR Bronze Dance tests or higher.
- 3) The skater regularly skates at least three (3) contract sessions weekly.
- 4) The skater is taking lessons in an individual skating discipline (freestyle, field moves, pairs or dance). Use of funds must be skating related, but is not limited to these disciplines.
- 5) The skater has exhibited good sportsmanship on and off the ice.
- 6) The award will allow the skater to advance or develop in skating in some way that he or she could not advance or develop without the award (i.e., attend a training camp, pay for extra lessons or a choreographer, take a dance class, etc.)**
