3. The skater complied with the Club's Volunteer Policy for the membership year of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017.
4. The skater owes no money to Rocky Mountain Figure Skating Club or its Synchronized Skating Teams.
5. The skater has not engaged in a continued pattern of violations of any tenet of the Club's SafeSport policies or any of the Club's Codes of Conduct.
